He has global expertise in educational reforms, training teachers, coaching schools and advising policy-makers. He has worked as a teacher, senior policy advisor and director in the Finnish Ministry of Education, and served at the World Bank (Washington, DC) and the European Commission (Torino, Italy) as an education expert. He is Adjunct Professor at the University of Helsinki and serves on the Board of Directors ASCD (Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development). His fields of interest include educational change, school improvement, cooperative learning and international education policy. His most recent book is titled, Finnish Lessons: What Can the World Learn About Educational Change in Finland? Dr. Sahlberg will be discussing the successful education reforms that have occurred in Finland and how they might be a model for our communities.
